

Resolution of the Health Benefit Exchange Board Certifying Outside Market Qualified Dental Plans

Whereas:

1. The Washington Health Benefit Exchange Board (the Board) is required to certify stand-alone dental plans that include Essential Health Benefits (EHB).
2. A stand-alone dental plan must meet certain federal certification criteria for qualified health plans in 45 CFR Parts 155 and 156 that apply to dental plans;
3. Delta Dental of Washington and Kaiser Foundation Health Plan of the Northwest are requesting certification for the stand-alone dental plans listed in Exhibit A to this resolution;
4. Each stand-alone dental plan listed in Exhibit A to this resolution has been found by the Insurance Commissioner to meet the applicable requirements of Title 48 RCW and the rules adopted to implement it; and
5. Each stand-alone dental plan listed in Exhibit A meets the requirements for certification as a qualified dental plan under the Affordable Care Act and the federal rules adopted to implement it.

Be it Resolved that:

Having satisfied the requirements for certification, the stand-alone dental plans listed in Exhibit A are CERTIFIED as qualified dental plans.
