# **Package Description**

## What is the problem, opportunity or priority you are addressing with the request?

In the enacted budget for the 2019-21 biennium, the PEBB funding rate increased to \$976. However, the Exchange's appropriation remained unchanged.

#### What is your proposal?

Ongoing Funding is requested to align the PEBB funding rate for the Health Benefit Exchange with that of state agencies and continue coverage at the new benefit rates established for the 2019-21 biennium.

#### How is your proposal impacting equity in the state?

By funding this request, the Exchange will be able to continue support nearly 25% of Washington's residents without having to reduce other operational areas.



# Decision Package 2021 Supplemental Budget

#### What are you purchasing and how does it solve the problem?

This request funds the increased employer contribution established in the 2019-21 biennial budget for staff benefits. This corrects a technical error from when the appropriation was provided to state agencies but missed for the Exchange.
